The A & E Selection Committee met on 23 January, 2008 to review the responses that were submitted and voted to short-list the following teams (in no particular order):

- Bliss & Nyitray w/ Thornton-Tomasetti, Brindley Pieters, and BASE
- Walter P. Moore w/ Brindley Pieters and TKW
- TLC w/ Arup, Brindley Pieters and BASE

The A & E Selection Committee interviewed the short-listed teams on 31 January, 2008 and voted to rank the teams in the following order:

- No. 1 ranked team: TLC w/ Arup, Brindley Pieters and BASE
- No. 2 ranked team: Walter P. Moore w/ Brindley Pieters and TKW
- No. 3 ranked team: Bliss & Nyitray w/ Thornton-Tomasetti, Brindley Pieters and BASE

HKS and Development Manager will enter into fee negotiations with the No.1 ranked team with the intention of entering into an agreement. If fee negotiations with the No. 1 ranked team are unsuccessful, negotiations with the No. 1 ranked team will be terminated and negotiations will begin with the next successively ranked teams until a contract is successfully negotiated.
